Note.

God Bless our clergy - dead and alive, is maírg do'n té a deárfadh focal ina naghaidh. However, in the past it would appear that some of them were willing to help with the angliciation of good Irish names even in places like Teelin where no English was spoken, and they made a bad job of some of the m. In my own young days the Irish form of most names was used even when young people were speaking in English (their own brand of English, not altogether the Kings's English), ach tháinig athrú ar an scéal, mo léan. Not alone is the English version of names being used at present but a whole array of new (foreign) names have been introduced. Caroline, Pamela, Adrian and various other are quite common now. Go mar sin féin, maybe a few comments on some of the names listed above would be of interest in a hundred years time, if not now.

It was common practice for Teelin people to say "Casadh Séamus Tamaí Andreas orm", or "I met S.Tamaí Aindreais", or "I met John Andy", or "casadh John Andy orm".

Anthony. The English form of this name was never used even when people spoke in english. Antoine was always used.

Bernard. The last of the name was born into English speaking household in the twenties and he was duly known as "Bernard" and is to this day. Every other man of the name was known either as Bryney, Barney or Bréidhni.

Charles. This name was generally known as Séarlaí, Tárlach or Charlie, whether Irish or English was being spoken. "I was up in Tárlach's house", or I prayed for Tom Phadaí Seárlaí" is what one would have heard in days gone by.

Connell. The variations of this name were Conall, Condaí, Condán, Con and Condy. Connie was also in use and still is.

Derby. Darby was never used in Teelin. Diarmuid and Doriby (not Dorby) that were used. The clergy (I hope they are all in Heaven) were responsible for the biblical version Jeremiah which has no correction whatever with "Diarmuid".

Daniel. Always known as Dómhnaill (not Dónal which would even yet be pronounced "Dawnil" in Teelin) until fairly recent times when "Dan" came into use when either Irish or English was being spoken.

Denis. was known in 1878 and up to my time as Donnchadha. Denis and Den were used occasionally.

Francis. The old Irish version was Prinnsín. Frainc and Fraincín were also used. The English versions were Frank and Francie. Prinnsín and Fraincín are never used now.

Hugh. is not an old Teelin name; it was brought in by OByrnes whenever they came to Teelin. It is also a Hegarty name. Hughie and Hudie (Hudaí) were the only versions used up about eighty years ago when Hugh came into use.

James. Séamus, Séinín, Séimicín and Seaminsín together with Jimí were the Irish forms of the name in use; and Jimmy in English.

John. John did not come into general use in Teelin until the first National School was opened there in 1838, I think. Indeed, the same can be said about other names. John Frainc Phrinnsín was a well known seanchaí whose surname was McBrearty, but nobody had to enquire who he was when described as above. His brothers were Niall and Dómhnaill Frainc Phrinnsín. The Irish version of their names was used. There were other mixtures such as Niall John Cheitsín, Oweny John Eóin etc. Johnny was also very much in use- in Irish and English.

Michael. Micheál and Mici in Irish, and Mickey in English were the forms of this name in general use. Rarely was Michael used.

Neil. Niall was used when either Irish or English was being spoken, and Neil was used only on rare occasions and only by certain individuals ?

Owen. Eóin was the only form of this name used until the National School altered things. In the mid eighties it became Owen, Oweny and John.

Patrick. The Irish forms of the name were Pádraig, Padaí, Paitsí/Páidín and Padán, but Pat was commonly used too. Such forms as Padai John Phádraig, Pat John Eóin etc were used. Pat was used when English was being spoken. Patrick is now used very often whether Irish or English is being spoken.

Peter. Peadar was generally used whether Irish or English was being spoken: Peadar Johnny Johndy, Peadar Phadaí Johnny, Peadar Phaitsí etc. I doubt if there is any Peter in Teelin at present.

Thomas. Tomás or Tamai were the Irish forms of the name, and Tammy was used as an English version as well.

William. The English version was nearly always used in spite of the fact that there were no supporters of a certain william in Teelin. Bill, Billy and Billí were also used. In fact there was an agheragh man who was known as Bill William Billí!

Agnes. The English form always used even in my day. Úna is sometimes used elsewhere as the Irish form for this name but never in Teelin. Úna was and is to this day the Irish for Winifred in Teelin. I knew one family in which there were two sisters - Winifred and Agnes. They were Byrnes who lived in Crobane.

Anne. Anna, Nansáí and Nanáí were the versions of this name used, whether Irish or English was being spoken, until the late 19 cent. When Anne got a foothold which it still holds. Nansáí (Nancy) and Nanáí (Nanny) are not used now.

Brigid. Brigid was rarely used up to the end of the last cent. Brighid, Biodáí (Biddy) and Brídeóg were the forms of the name in use. Brídeóg is not used now.

Catherine. Until comparatively recent times Kate, Kit and Kitty were the English versions of this name and Ciot, Ciotáí the Irish forms. Catherine and Caitlín were rarely used. One lady named Cassidy whom I remember was known as "Kyty".

Ellen. This form of the name was commonly used whether Irish or English was being spoken but Nelly and Nilly (Nillie) were also used. Nellí and Nillí were the Irish versions as well. Eibhlín was seldom used.

Hannah. Hannah and Norah were on a fifty fifty basis more or less but Nóra was the only Irish versions. Hannah was also used when Irish was being spoken.

Mally. was an old Irish name in Teelin but it was used in other parts of the parish as well. Mailigh is the Irish version. (My great, great frandmother on my mother's side was Mailigh Bheag Ní Eochaidh and her husband's mother was also a Mhailigh; he was known as Séamus Mhailigh Mac Cuinneagáin.

Margaret. Peigí (Peggy), Maggie and Maragit were the versions in use. Máighreád (Maireád) only came into use in recent times.

Mary. For over a hundred years at least Mary was often used even when Irish was being spoken and Máire when English when English was being spoken. A person would say " I met Máire hEochaidh or I met Mary Néill".

Rose. Rósie was the only form of this name until recent times.

Sarah. The English version was invariably used even when Irish was being spoken. The forebears of the name came from English speaking areas; it is not an old Teelin name. (Searia)

Susan. The English version came into use in recent times. Siubhán was the form of the name in use at the turn of the century.

Winifred. See Agnes above.

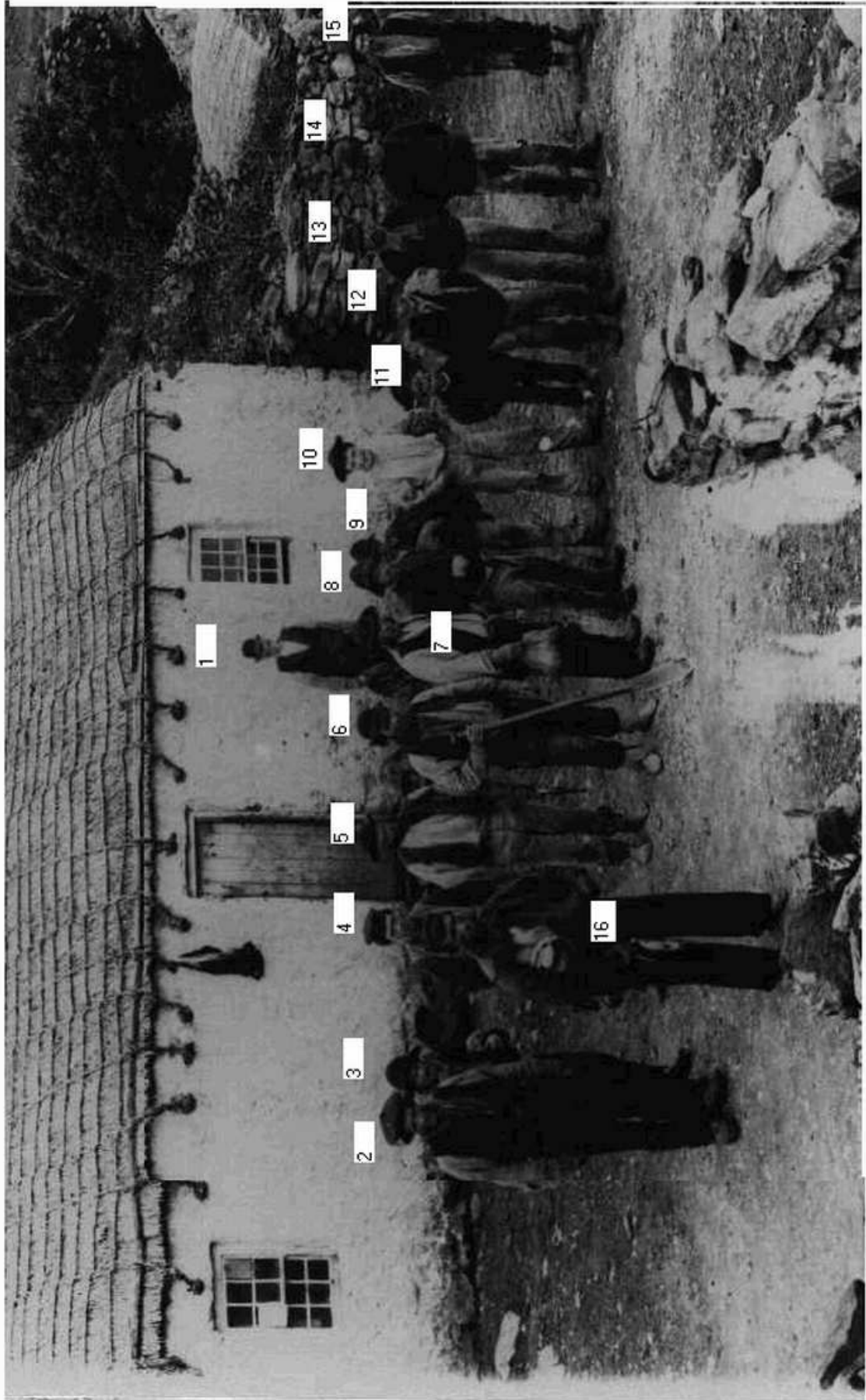
Enclosed is a copy of a Photograph of Teelin fishermen taken by William Mervin Lawrence in July 1890. The Photograph was taken outside Pat Philly's house; note the Brat Bhríde hanging on the wall. Paddy Mháire McShane knew all the fishermen's names but he failed to write them down. I inquired of his son Diarmud but he knew but a few of them. Below are the names as my Father remembered them.
