## **Mathew 10:37-42**

Few of us are given the chance to perform great deeds. But the chance to give a cup of water can come our way several times in the course of a day. The 'cup of cold water' is a symbol of the small kind deed. Little deeds may not look much, but they can bring peace.

An Australian priest visiting Ireland went into Dublin. That evening he was asked how he found Dublin. He replied, Dublin must be one of the few cities in the world where people will hold a door open for you, or will say "Sorry" if they accidentally bump into you, or "Excuse me" if they have to squeeze past you,' was his reply.

The things he referred to were very small in themselves. Yet the accumulation of those little things led him to conclude that Dublin is basically a friendly place. Little flowers may appear to have no scent on their own. But put a bunch of them together and they can fill a room with fragrance.

Deeds don't have to be big in order to be of help and comfort to the person for whom they are done. They just have to have a certain quality. What is this quality? It is warmth. All deeds which come from the heart have this warmth.
