#### JOHN 20:19-23

The Bush-people of Africa (the Bushmen) were the first inhabitants of the continent. But down the centuries they suffered persecution at the hands of both white people and black people. Today there is only a remnant of them left in Southern Africa, in and around the Kalahari desert. They are used to living in wide open spaces. Most people would find such an environment almost unbearable. Not so the Bush-people. For them it is their element.

Once a Bushman was imprisoned because he had killed a giant bustard, which was a crime, since the bustard is a protected species. Locked up in a small cell, he began to waste away like a candle. He had sufficient food and drink, yet he continued to pine away.

Puzzled and alarmed, the authorities called in a doctor to examine him. The doctor gave him a thorough examination, but could find nothing wrong with him physically. When asked why he was ill all the man could say was, 'I can't live without being able to see the sun go down over the Kalahari desert.'

I don't know how the story ended, but I hope the authorities had the good sense to release him. His problem was not lack of food for his body, but lack of nourishment for his spirit. It was his spirit not his body that was dying.

Because the spirit is easily broken, easily crushed, It needs strengthening and nourishing every bit as much as the body does. If strengthened and nourished it has great powers of recovery.

What are the things that strengthen and nourish the spirit? What is it that enables the spirit to soar, and what IS It that causes It to sink?

Sadness weighs it down; joy lifts it up.

Criticism erodes it; praise builds it up.

Failure shrinks it; praise builds it up.

Despair causes it to wilt; hope breathes new life into it.

Rejection wounds it; acceptance heals it.

Hatred poisons it; love purifies it.

Fear cripples it; solitude calms it; prayer strengths it.

The Holy Spirit continually breathes new life into our spirits. So, as we prepare for the feast of Pentecost, we might make our own the prayer: Spirit of the living God, fall afresh on us.
